

DAY 1:

Family Worship

- Get your Bibles out and read Luke 2:1-7 Jesus is born.
- Life App: **Christmas**
Celebrating Jesus, God's greatest gift
- This week we are learning that God loved us so much that He gave us a Savior.

DAY 2:

Read Luke 2:6-7

Grab a piece of paper and pretend for a second that you are the king of a very large kingdom. What would your throne room, or royal playroom look like? Draw it on the page. If you have a nativity at home, go stand near it and hold up your picture. Spot any differences?

When Mary and Joseph traveled to Bethlehem, they couldn't find a place stay. So they ended up rooming with animals. And it was there that Jesus, our Savior, was born. The surroundings were so humble that the King of all Kings wasn't placed in a beautifully carved crib. Instead, this precious gift to the whole world was nestled into an animal feed box.

Jesus didn't come as a king to rule over us. Jesus came as one of us so that He could save us. Set the baby Jesus from your nativity on top of your drawing. Then spend a few minutes thanking God for loving you so much that He would send His only Son to save you.

DAY 3:

The Best Gift

Ask an adult to help you look up this week's Bible story in Luke 2:1-7 and read it together. What does our story tell us? Jesus was born! God loved us so much that He gave us a Savior. Find one of your favorite Christmas songs and sing it with your family. Bonus points if you can find one with the word "joy" or "hope."

Know that God loved us so much that He gave us Jesus!

DAY 4:

Read Galatians 4:4

Have you ever read the book Goldilocks and the Three Bears? Goldilocks breaks into the bear's house and tries their porridge, their chairs, and even their beds until she finds one that is "just right."

Remember last week when we talked about how God had a big plan to rescue us? How He knew from the very beginning that He would send His only Son as our Savior? When the time was "just right" God sent Jesus as a baby, the greatest gift ever. God sent His Son at the chosen time because He loved us that much.

Write this week's bottom line on an index card (God loved us so much that He gave us a Savior.) and place it next to your favorite Christmas decoration. Thank God for sending Jesus at just the right time because of His love for you.

DAY 5:

Let's Have Cake!

Ask an adult to help you look up John 3:16. Christmas is a time when we celebrate the birth of Jesus—God's greatest gift. Using craft supplies, draw and decorate a cake that would be fit for celebrating Jesus! Think about what it would look like or what it would say. After, spend some time thanking God for sending Jesus to be our Savior. Pray something like this: Dear God, Thank You for loving me so much that You sent Your Son, Jesus. Help me celebrate Jesus today and always. I love you, God. Amen.
